Synopsis of Courses

Each Course contains 5 to 10 Topics. Topics content comprises short videos (3-7 minutes), concise text, links to exercises, data sources, longer articles and research papers. Videos are edited from a range of social scientists around the world, having gained their permission to use them in the courses. A Quiz completes each Course. At the initial stage no formal assessment is included, although a completion certificate is generated. Courses may be individually selected as participants choose. The Categories form a logical progression from foundation knowledge to applied environments.
